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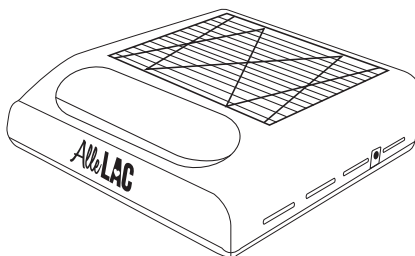

1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

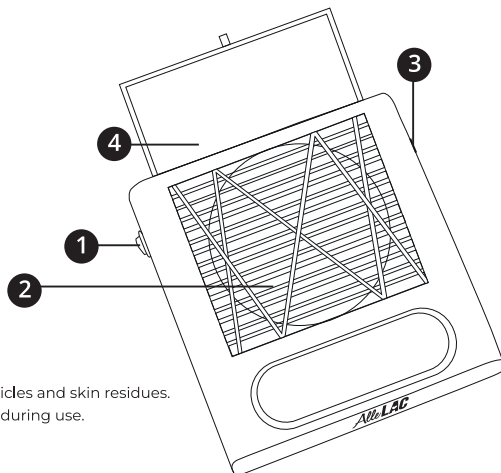
1. Read this manual carefully before using the device.
2. Replace the cartridge filter regularly.
3. Do not touch the fan while the device is operating.
4. Clean the device only with a dry cloth.
5. Do not pull the power cord.
6. Make sure that the supply voltage corresponds to the device specifications.
7. Do not disconnect the device from the power supply while it is operating. Switch it off first.
8. Use and store the device in a dry environment, away from water and moisture. Contact with moisture may cause damage to the device or electric shock.
9. Disconnect the device from the power supply after use.
10. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by an authorized service center.
11. Do not attempt to repair or modify the device yourself. Unauthorized modifications may void the warranty.
12. Keep the device out of reach of children.

1. ON/OFF switch (I/O)
2. Fan

4. MAIN FUNCTIONS:

- Essential device for nail styling and podiatry treatments.
- High suction power ensures effective absorption of dust, nail particles and skin residues.
- Easy operation - place hands or feet near the ventilation opening during use.
- Smooth surface provides comfort for the client during treatment.

5. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

1. Connect the device to the power supply and turn the device on using the ON/OFF switch.
2. Place hands or feet over the dust collector grille during operation.
3. After use, switch off the device and disconnect it from the power supply.



In accordance with art. 13 sec. 1 of the Act of 11 September 2015 on used electrical and electronic equipment (Journal of Laws 2015 item 1688), we inform you about the correct handling of waste electrical and electronic equipment:
